Long Game

How to play your Fairway metals and how to hit the Driver. Bring all your Fairway metals and your Driver.

July 5th

Putting

You will learn the mechanics of a good putting stroke, distance control, how to read greens, and helpful putting drills. Bring your Putter.

July 12th

Iron Game

We will learn how to play an iron shot. Please bring your Irons and Hybrids.

July 19th

Long Game

How to play your Fairway metals and how to hit the Driver. Bring all your Fairway metals and your Driver.

July 26th

Short Game
